Purpose of Position

The Accountant has responsibility for:

- 1) Maintenance and control of the accounting functions including integrity of the general ledger, internal controls, reconciliations, cash flow and financial reporting.
- 2) Financial support for business units including budget / forecast preparation and monitoring actual spend

Reporting/working relationships

This position reports to the Chief Financial Officer and is responsible for managing the Accounts Administrator. The position works closely with the Project Accountant and staff within business units including ticketing, marketing and operations.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1) Management Accounting
 - Assist with budget / forecast preparation and monitoring actual spend
- 2) Transactional processing
 - Oversee accounts payable and receivable
 - Venue and overseas artist settlements
 - Manage weekly EFT transactions
- 3) Cash / Treasury management
 - Facilitate foreign exchange transactions
 - Maintain Development Fund account
 - Produce and maintain monthly cash flow and balances report
 - Manage Term Deposits

4) Reporting

- Work with the Chief Financial Officer on preparation of annual accounts
- Assist in the preparation of Board papers
- APRA reporting
- Australia Council and Annual report statistics
- Produce and maintain trial balance, management accounts, overhead and ticketing reports
- FBT and workers compensation returns
- · Assist with grant acquittals and applications

5) GL maintenance and reconciliations

- Ensure the integrity and accuracy of all financial records
- Create, update and maintain ledger structure and accounting software
- Reconcile ticketing and development income
- Supervise and monitor reconciliation of all balance sheet accounts including clearing, contra, accrual and prepayment accounts
- Maintain fixed asset register
- 6) Direct and supervise Accounts Administrator
- 7) Provide cover for Project Accountant in processing and maintaining company payroll
- 8) Maintain Stradivarius / Australian Music Foundation accounts and assist in the preparation of Board papers and reports
